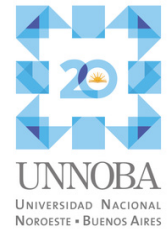

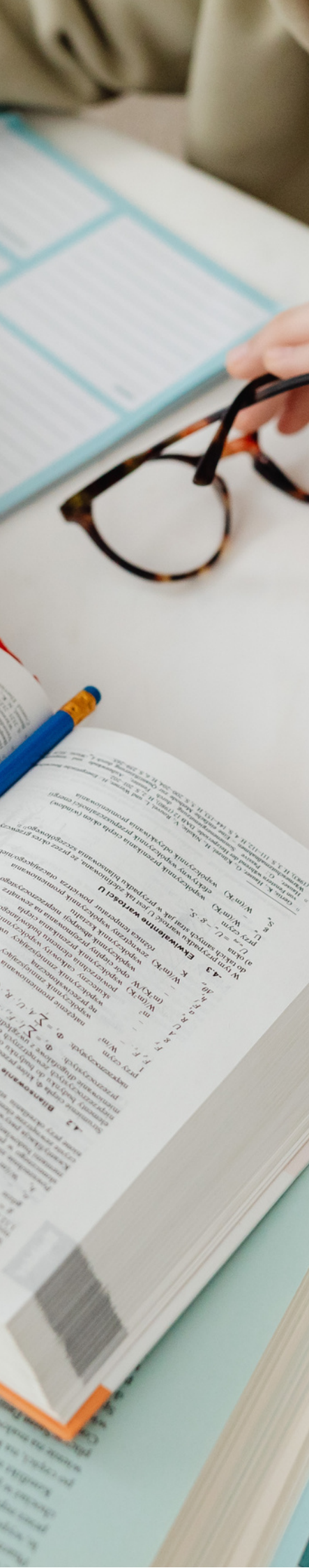
ABOUT UNNOBA



UNNOBA (National University of the North West of the Province of Buenos Aires) was established in 2002. It is a state-run, national, and free university that plays a leading role in the region. It has premises in Junin and Pergamino, two important cities in the pampas region, about 250 km away from Buenos Aires City.

The National University of the North West of the Province of Buenos Aires comprises three Schools: The School of Agricultural, Natural and Environmental Sciences; the School of Technology and the School of Economics and Law; and two Institutes: the Institute of Human Development and the Institute of Graduate Studies.

The National University of the North West of the Province of Buenos Aires is based in the heart of Argentina's farming area. It enrolls about 10,000 students from Argentina. Because of its setting, this University has gained, since its founding, a strategic position in Agricultural Sciences and Technology.



Consolidating its position as a host university in these strategic areas is one of UNNOBA's main objectives.

The mission of the International Relations Office of UNNOBA is to foster mobility, relationships and cooperation with universities, research centers and international organizations engaged in higher education, teaching, research, knowledge and culture.

UNNOBA has signed several agreements with prestigious higher education institutions in Latin America and the Caribbean, Europe, the United States, China and other countries in Asia and Africa in order to promote the mobility of undergraduate and graduate students, professors and researchers.

As part of the internationalization process, the National University of the North West of the Province of Buenos Aires has joined the Montevideo Group Association for Universities (AUGM), the Association of Universities of Latin America and the Caribbean (UDUAL) and the Inter-American Organization for Higher Education (OUI) and OBREAL Global.

COURSES OF STUDY

UNNOBA offers a wide variety of courses related to the social and the productive development of the region.


At present, UNNOBA delivers 23 courses in the following fields: Computer Science, Engineering, Design, Food Industry, Agronomy, Genetics, Economics, Law, and Health.

The Institute of Graduate Studies delivers diploma programs, specialization courses, master's degrees, and doctorates.

UNNOBA also runs a free secondary school, Presidente Domingo Faustino Sarmiento, which adopted a comprehensive approach, focusing on intellectual and practical competencies.

The Territorialisation Plan launched by UNNOBA in 2015 offers academic and extension programs in numerous cities in the North Western region of the province of Buenos Aires.


COOPERATION WITH AFRICA



The cooperation between National University of the North West of the Province of Buenos Aires and Africa is in its initial stage. UNNOBA has signed agreements with African universities and sent a mission to Angola to strengthen academic, research, and extension relations concerning food, energy, technological innovation, and sustainable development.

As a follow-up to this mission, representatives of the Agostinho Neto and Lueji A'Nkonde Universities from Angola visited our university. In 2019, we received the ambassador of Angola in Argentina.

CAPABILITIES AND OPPORTUNITIES



UNNOBA is a state-run and free university. As such, it has the resources to guarantee higher education to all of those willing to get a degree.

Likewise, UNNOBA seeks to define, develop, and execute a cooperation policy based on complementarity to carry out joint activities and partnerships that contribute to mutual benefit.
