POLICY OPTIONS

National strategies and policies

Countries are encouraged to incorporate intercultural dialogue into their national strategies on migration and youth integration.

Educational initiatives

Integrating intercultural education into school curricula and creating inclusive educational environments that reflect and celebrate diversity.

Community-based programs

Implementing EU-funded initiatives and local projects to support migrant youth integration through workshops, training, and cultural exchange events.

Intercultural mediators

Developing intercultural mediator roles to facilitate communication between migrants and authorities, addressing the unique needs of migrant youth.

European identity building

Participating in EU-funded initiatives that bring together young people from different backgrounds to engage in intercultural dialogue and develop a shared sense of European identity.



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
